Dear Participant,

On these pages you will find information about the processing of your personal data associated with the webinar event of SHUTTLE project.

Purpose: The purposes of the processing of your personal data are the management and organization of the webinar (including access of the participants to the webinar management of audio recordings, and publication of the recordings on SHUTTLE website at <https://www.shuttle-pcp.eu/>), as well as for transparency reasons of the procurement contest (including equal treatment, equal information sharing to all participants). A participants' list will be made available among all attendees. We will not use personal data for any other purpose, unless a new legal basis exists, in which case you will be notified or asked for renewed consent with full information about the further processing.

Personal data processed are:

- Identifiers and contact information such as name, surname, organization, email address;
- Audio recordings of groups of participants (attendees and/or speakers) and organizers.

Legal basis:

- 1) You give consent to the processing of your personal data for the reason of processing audio recordings as well as contacting you in future events of interest by checking (in platform) [Article 6, 1(a) GDPR];
- 2) Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which you are party or in order to take steps at the request of you prior to entering into a contract, regarding the management of the participation list. [Article 6,1(b) GDPR].

2) Data Controller: The Center for Security Studies “KEMEA”, an established Research Centre within the Hellenic Ministry of Citizen Protection with offices at 4, P. Kanellopoulou str., 10177, Athens Greece, is the Data Controller of your personal data’s processing for the purposes explicitly identified below.

Recipients: KEMEA’s staff, , SHUTTLE’ partners, stakeholders.

Transfer: Regarding transfer to third parties, take into account that part of SHUTTLE Consortium is MINISTRY OF PUBLIC SECURITY – ISRAEL NATIONAL POLICE (MOPS - INP) is established in Israel, a third country, which however holds adequacy decision as far as protection of personal data is concerned. Audio recordings will be published in <https://www.shuttle-pcp.eu> website, whose access is publicly available. Please be aware that for this purpose audios on this website <https://www.shuttle-pcp.eu> can be viewed throughout the world and not just in the EU and that some countries may not provide the same level of data protection as EU legislation.

Personal Data Retention: Your personal data will be retained by KEMEA for no more than 5 years following the webinar’s end for transparency reasons unless you provide your consent for the purpose of contacting you in the future exclusively in the context of inviting you to future events of interest.

Your Rights: Under certain circumstances, by law you have the right to:

- Request information about whether we hold personal information about you, and, if so, what that information is and why we are holding/using it.
- Request access to your personal information (commonly known as a "data subject access request"). This enables you to receive a copy of the personal information we hold about you and to check that we are lawfully processing it.
- Request rectification of the personal information that we hold about you. This enables you to have any incomplete or inaccurate information we hold about you corrected.
- Request erasure of your personal information. This enables you to ask us to delete or remove personal information where there is no good reason for us continuing to process it.
- Request the restriction of processing of your personal information. This enables you to ask us to suspend the processing of personal information about you.
- Request transfer of your personal information in an electronic and structured form to you or to another party (commonly known as a right to “data portability”). This enables you to take your data from us in an electronically useable format and to be able to transfer your data to another party in an electronically useable format.
- Lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (<http://www.dpa.gr>).
